EDUCATION PROGRAM CHAIR

- The 11th Edition revision is underway with the majority of Student Manual chapter drafts submitted. The Student Manual is being reorganized to align with the Skills Stations (Airway, Breathing, Circulation, etc.) and rewritten to focus on the core principles of ATLS.
- Work is currently being done on the Interactive Discussions, mATLS online modules (which are being redesigned/redeveloped), and the Skills Stations.
- All product lines for ATLS will go through a Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) review and a FLEX review before being finalized. FLEX review includes ensuring various mechanisms of injury, practice environments, and resource availability are represented.
- Current videos are being reviewed by the Video Workgroup for what will be included in the MyATLS mobile app (anticipated launch of Version 1.0 is early 2024), and to identify which videos need to be redone for the ATLS 11th Edition. The Workgroup will also develop scripts for the new videos.
- The Education Technology Workgroup is developing quiz questions, flashcards, and case scenarios for the launch of the MyATLS mobile app. 10th Edition content will be included until the hard launch of ATLS 11, at which time the updated content will be included.
- Piloting of ATLS 11th Instructor Course is underway with anticipated completion of 6 Pilot Courses by the end of 2024. These Pilots will inform a final version to be launched in early 2025.
- There are currently no plans to have a fully online Refresher course.
- More than 200 volunteers are involved in this revision – **thank you to all!**

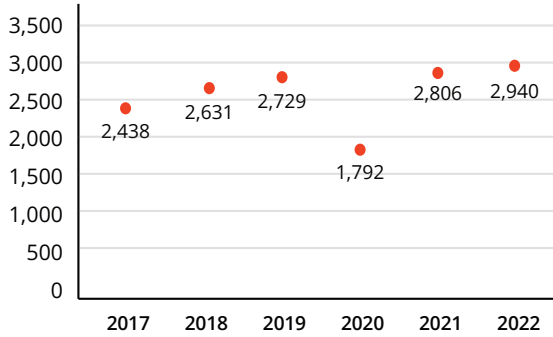
- Collaboration between RTTDC Education Program Chair and the Rural Trauma Committee; developing a proposal for a new Rural Trauma Program

TBI Guidelines Course | Partnership with the Brain Trauma Foundation

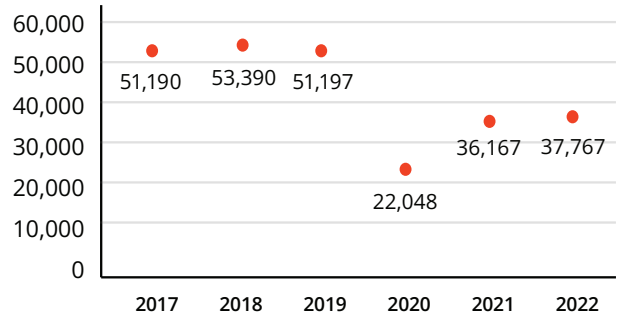
- The Brain Trauma Foundation (BTF) created a one-hour online module, focusing on the Traumatic Brain Injury Guidelines

- Anticipated launch is December 2023



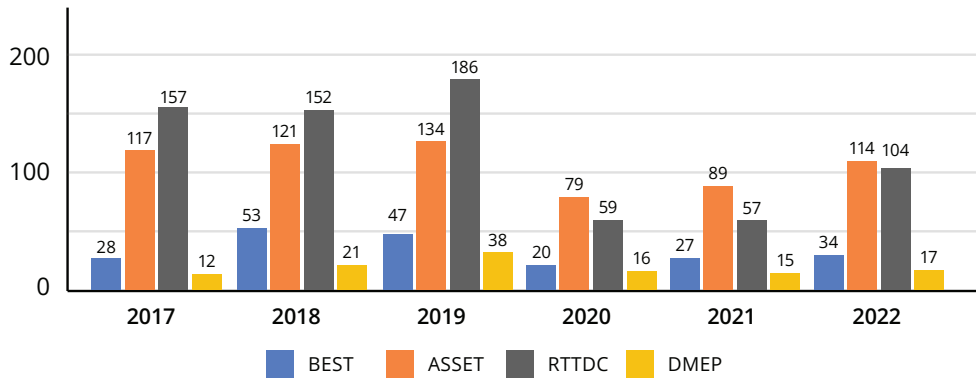
ATLS | Total # of **Courses**



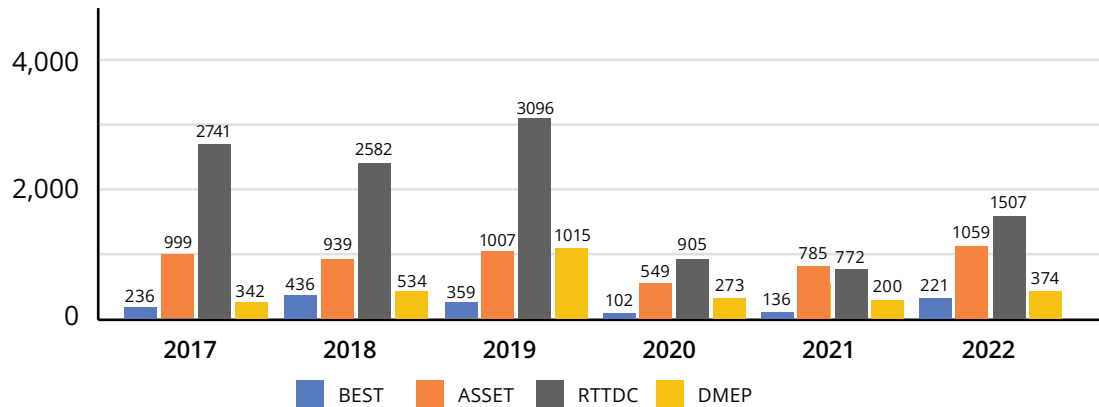
ATLS | Total # of **Learners**
